7 PM, 2nd Monday

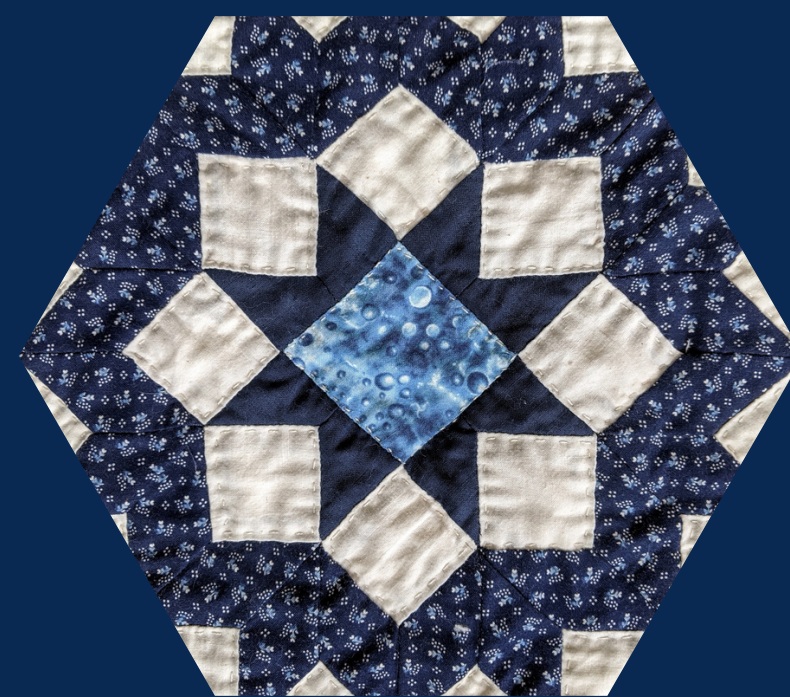
Come early - the Ways & Means Sale
