This Mystery Class allows you to USE UP YOUR STASH, if you choose, or use your favorite line of fabrics to create the beautiful 44" x 44" Wall Quilt, "Virginia Dogwoods". There will be door prizes and a lot of fun! The class is FREE. You only need to purchase the pattern from Lori which is \$10. VCQ Members and non-members are ALL invited to sign up. Class is Dec. 31 from 10 AM -5 PM. Signing up is a three-step process:
